

Day 8 Lesson Plan: 3/5

Topic: Build Your Own New Deal

- Build Your Own New Deal: Evaluative Summative Assessment Project

Objectives

- Students will apply their knowledge of the New Deal to the assessment project.
- Students will evaluate the success of individual New Deal programs or policies.
- Students will create their own “New Deal” by revising and explaining New Deal programs and policies.

Materials

- Laptop cart
- Project prompt worksheet
- Powerpoint

Activities

1. *Warm-Up Activity:* In your exit ticket from yesterday’s class, did you write that the New Deal was successful or unsuccessful?
 - a. Have students answer this question individually in their weekly warm-up worksheet, then share and discuss their answers as a class.
2. *Activity:* Build Your Own New Deal
 - a. Instruct students that they will work in groups of 2-3 students to complete an in-class project. Distribute project instructions to students. Explain that students will be creating their own version of the New Deal, and that they must pick three programs to adopt or revise for the program. Students must turn in a poster with a description and explanation of their plan.
 - b. Instruct students to pick up a laptop from the laptop cart. Students will work on the project for the remainder of class time.

Assessment

- Formatively assess students’ knowledge by monitoring their activity throughout class.
- Summatively assess students’ knowledge through their project submission.
