

Day 9 Lesson Plan: 3/6

Topic: Great Depression Review

- Review Great Depression Unit Objectives and Essential Knowledge

Objectives

- Students will apply their knowledge of the New Deal to the assessment project.
- Students will evaluate the success of individual New Deal programs or policies.
- Students will create their own “New Deal” by revising and explaining New Deal programs and policies.

Materials

- Laptop cart
- Unit test study guide

Activities

1. *Warm-Up Activity:* What was the most interesting thing you learned this unit? What was your favorite lesson or classroom activity?
 - a. Have students answer this question individually in their weekly warm-up worksheet, then share and discuss their answers as a class.
2. *Activity:* Build Your Own New Deal
 - a. Instruct students that they have a half an hour to complete their New Deal projects, if needed. Have students pick up laptops in order to do so.
3. *Activity:* Class Review and Quizlet
 - a. Instruct students that they have the remainder of class to complete the unit review study guide in their small desk groups. Answer or clarify any questions.
 - b. Instruct students that they can review for the test by using Quizlet on their laptops.

Assessment

- Formatively assess students’ knowledge by monitoring their activity throughout class and participation in the warm-up discussion.
- Summatively assess students’ knowledge through their project submission.
