

Day 6 Lesson Plan: 3/3

Topic: Programs of the New Deal

- Features of the New Deal: Programs and Policies
- Purpose of New Deal Programs

Objectives

- Students will learn about the features of the New Deal.
- Students will use textbooks to conduct research about an assigned program or policy of the New Deal.
- Students will present their information to the class.

Materials

- Powerpoint presentation
- Class set of textbooks
- Cloze notes
- Data retrieval packets

Activities

1. *Warm-Up Activity*: How were Hoover and FDR's responses to the Great Depression different?
 - a. Have students answer this question individually in their weekly warm-up worksheet, then share and discuss their answers as a class.
2. *Lecture*: New Deal Programs and Policies
 - a. Using Cloze notes in their Great Depression packets, instruct students to take notes during a brief lecture on the programs and policies of the New Deal. Engage students during the lecture, asking questions and encouraging appropriate discussion and active engagement.
3. *Activity*: New Deal Research
 - a. Instruct students that they will work in groups to research their an assigned New Deal program or policy using the class set of textbooks. Have students complete the corresponding worksheet for their research.
 - b. Once students have completed their research, have each group present their program or policy to the entire class.

Assessment

- Formatively assess students' knowledge by monitoring their participation in the class lecture, and actions during the textbook research.
- Summatively assess students' knowledge at the end of the lesson with the oral presentations.
